Introduction

State Demographic Profile

Florida is a peninsula that is geographically located in the most southeastern region of the U.S. and is bordered by Georgia and Alabama. Florida is comprised of 67 counties. The 2021 American Community Survey from the U.S. Census Bureau estimates there are 17,078,449 Florida residents over the age of 18. The approximate racial/ethnic breakdown according to the 2021 ACS estimates is as follows: 52.6% white, 15.1% Black, 26.2% Hispanic/Latino origin, and 2.7% Asian. FDOT's 2021 Public Road Mileage and Travel (DVMT) Report counts a total of 123,652 miles of public roads in the state of Florida, including interstate, state, county, and city roads.

Project Background

FDOT has several motorcycle safety messages that are distributed to the public by Ride Smart Florida, an extension of the Florida Motorcycle Safety Coalition. Ride Smart Florida uses data-driven research to develop, implement and evaluate measures to prevent motorcycle fatalities, including motorcycle safety campaigns. This report measures exposure to the *Ride Smart* campaign, as well as two safety messages: *Don't Drink and Ride*, and *Watch for Motorcycles*. The *Don't Drink and Ride* safety message targets motorcyclists specifically, while the *Watch for Motorcycles* message is aimed at vehicle drivers.

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) Motorcycle Traffic Safety Fact Sheet, Florida saw 612 motorcyclist fatalities in 2021, up from 564 in 2020, and 559 in 2021. Traffic fatality data is sourced from Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS) Annual Report File (ARF).

Methodology

Study Purpose

This report serves to inform FDOT about the effectiveness of their motorcycle safety campaigns, which were distributed in the hopes of raising motorcycle

awareness and decreasing motorcycle-related crashes. In order to best accomplish this, the Public Opinion Research Lab (PORL) at the University of North Florida (UNF) conducted a survey measuring behavior and awareness surrounding motorcycle safety.

PORL collected information about the attitudes and awareness of adults living in the 10 Florida counties that experience some of the most serious injuries and fatal motorcycle crashes in the State of Florida (see Table 1). Both motorcyclists and non-motorcyclists were asked about FDOT's motorcycle safety campaigns and their general driving habits. The performance goal is to monitor the progress of FDOT's motorcycle safety awareness campaigns and their coverage throughout these key counties.

Study Design

In the effort to accurately capture the awareness and driving habits of adult Florida drivers and motorcycle riders, a mixed-mode approach was used, incorporating both telephone and online surveys for a total sample of 1,627 responses.

All surveys were conducted within the 10 counties shown in Table 1 below. Quotas were placed on the

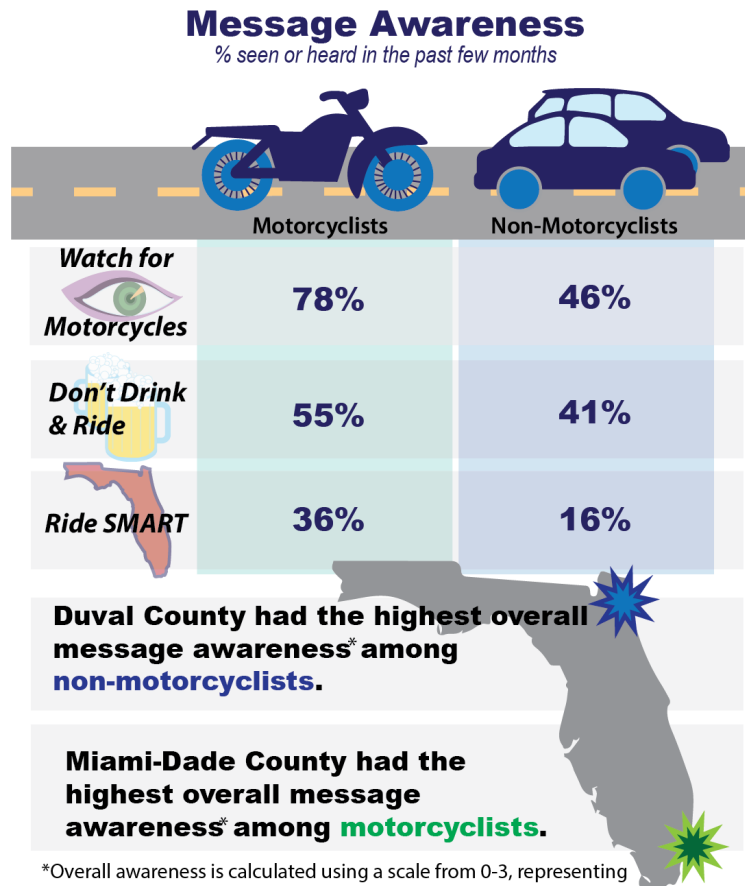
telephone survey for each of the 10 counties to ensure approximately 100 non-motorcyclists were completed for each county. This helps to decrease margin of sampling error when cross analyzing counties (see Table 1).

The online portion of the study was administered using two companies: Qualtrics, a platform used to distribute web based surveys and Cint, an online panel provider, that helped create a panel of qualified respondents. PORL conducted the online survey between June 19 and June 23, 2023. The online sample consists of 1,306 completed responses.

The telephone survey was conducted between June 21 and June 30, 2023 and consisted of licensed drivers in each of the 10 counties, garnering 321 completed responses. An oversample of

adult Florida motorcycle riders was used to target motorcyclists who have ridden in the past 12 months.

Figure 1. Executive Summary



Data collection took place at the PORL facility with its 27-station Computer Assisted Telephone Interviewing (CATI) system. A single interviewer, through hand dialing, upon reaching individuals answering on a cell phone or landline telephone sample, asked the first qualified respondent to participate in the telephone survey. For the telephone sample, the breakdown of completed responses on a landline phone to a cell phone was 13% to 87% with less than 1% unknown.

Up to six callbacks were attempted for non-completes with a working residential or cell phone line. To avoid survey bias, surveys were conducted in both English and Spanish. Calls were made from 4:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 12:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. on Saturday. Marketing Systems Group (MSG) provided all the targeted motorcyclist phone numbers used for the telephone survey.

The response rates for the telephone sample was 4.5% using the American Association of Public Opinion Research (AAPOR) Response Rate 3 (RR3) calculation, which estimates the proportion of cases of unknown eligibility are truly eligible.

The study has an overall margin of error of +/- 3.06 percentage points, including estimated design effects. It is important to note that, due to smaller sample sizes, the observations made between counties have a greater margin of error, indicating a greater degree of uncertainty toward the true population than that of the entire sample. Table 1 shows the sample sizes of each of the 10 Florida counties surveyed, and Table 2 displays the margins of error for each.

To adjust for the oversampling of smaller counties and to correct for non-response bias, weights were applied to the data. To ensure the results presented are representative of the population of study, the data were weighted by age, sex, education, race and ethnicity, and geography to the 2021 ACS 5-year estimates for the adult population of the 10 Florida counties surveyed. Respondents that answered at least one of those questions with 'Don't Know' or 'Refusal' were given a weight of 1. Finally, the motorcyclists were weighted to motorcyclist demographic data collected from the phone samples of the past four project years.

As members of AAPOR, the PORL's goal is to support sound and ethical practices in the conduct of survey and public opinion research. Moreover, the PORL is a charter member of the AAPOR Transparency Initiative and a member of the Association of Academic Survey Research Organizations.

Summary of Findings

The figures on the following pages represent data from the 2023 survey, as well as longitudinal data from previous years where applicable. These findings are separated into motorcyclists and non-motorcyclists for comparison.

The infographic below displays the demographic data of the 2023 sample, also broken down by motorcyclists and non-motorcyclists.

Figure 2. Respondent Profile

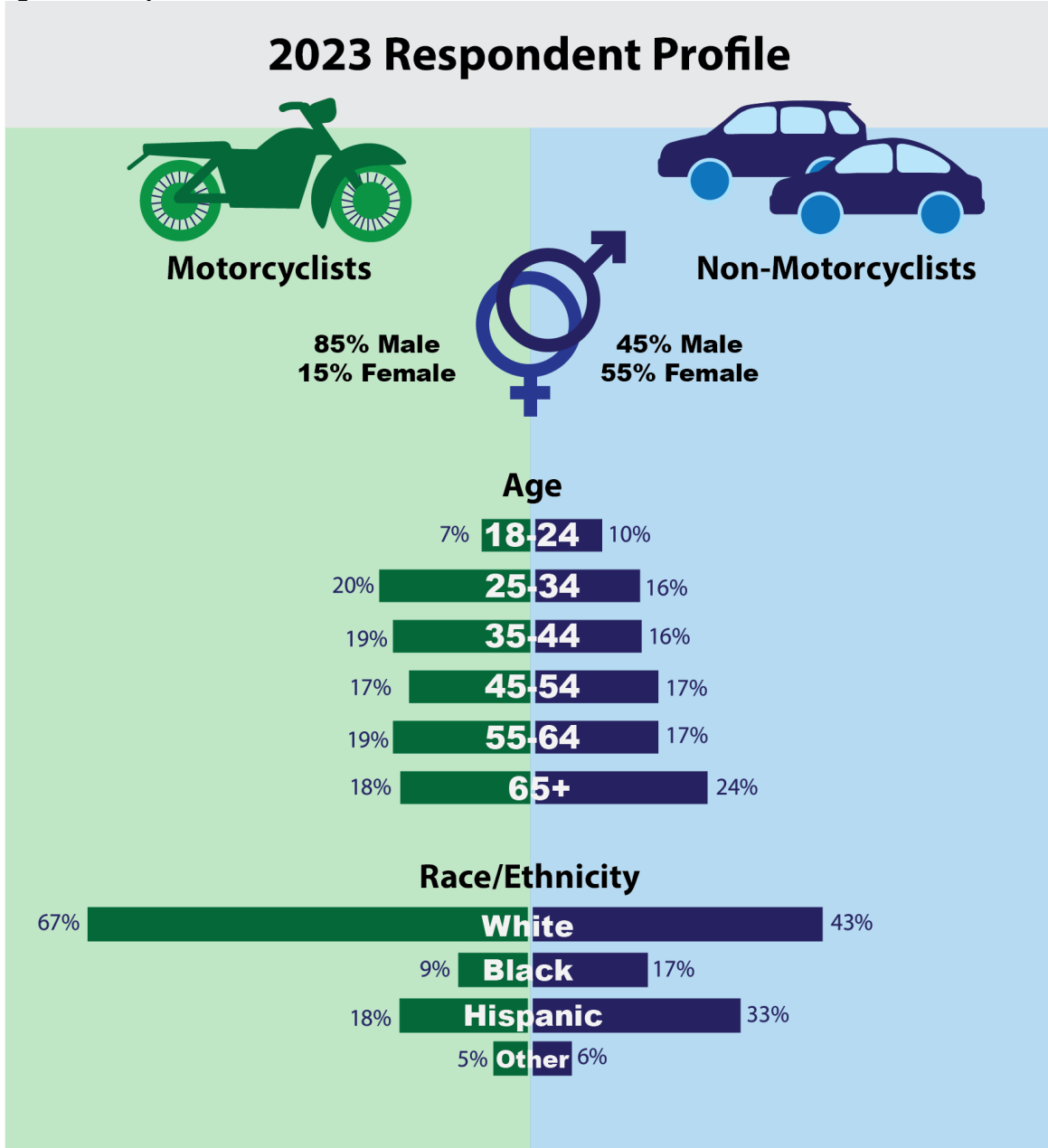
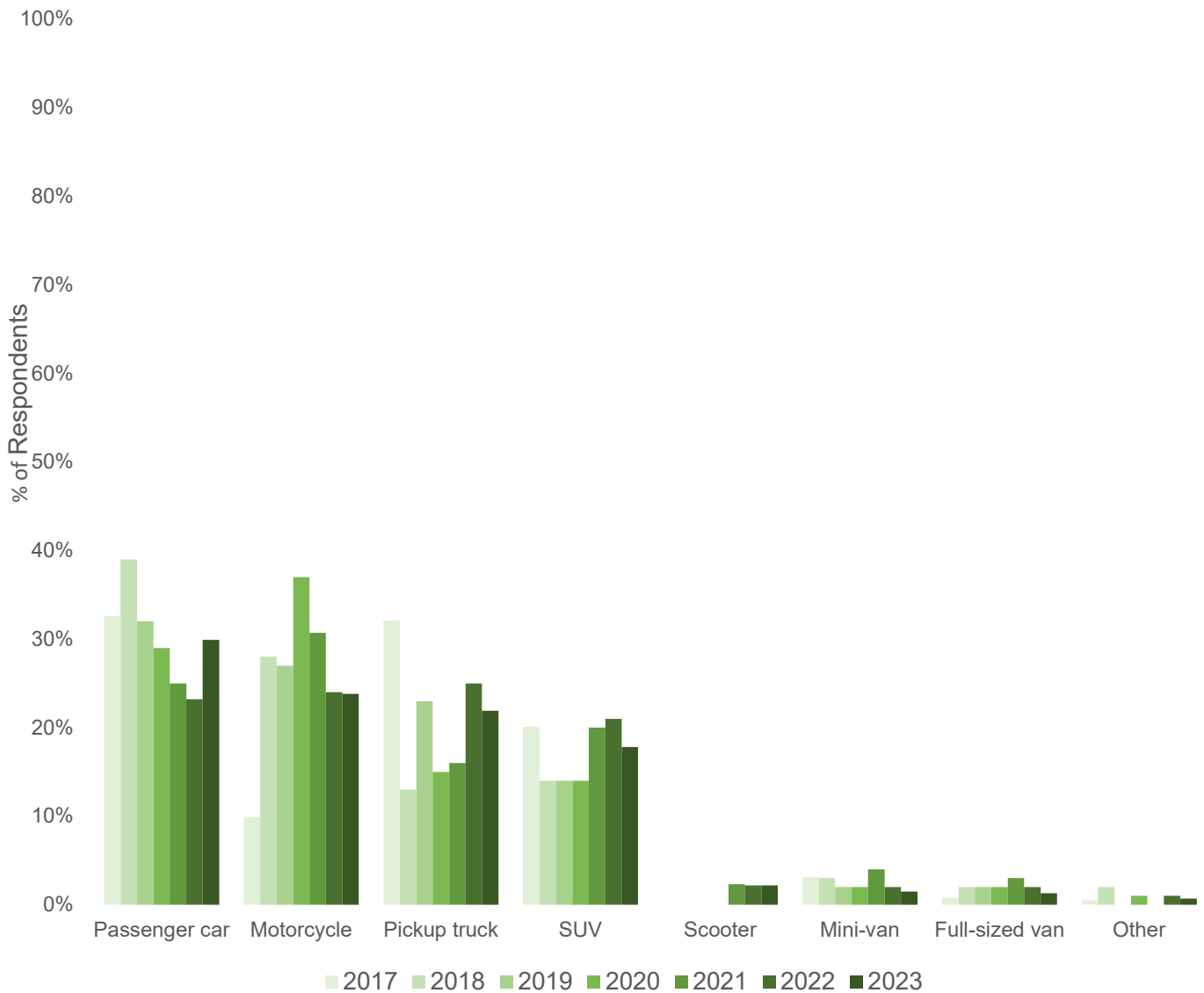


Figure 3a. Motorcyclists Vehicle Driven, 2017-2023

Motorcyclists: In general, what type of vehicle do you drive most often?



All respondents were first asked what type of vehicle they drive most often. Figures 3a and 3b display these responses for each project year, broken down by motorcyclists and non-motorcyclists.

Among motorcyclists, the vehicle type most often driven is the passenger car with 30%, followed by motorcycles at 24%. The percentage of motorcyclists who reported

driving a passenger car most often increased by seven percentage points since 2022, while the percentage who mostly drive motorcycles remained steady. The percentage of motorcyclists who reported driving pickup trucks and SUVs most often also fell in 2023, at 22% and 18%, respectively. Since scooters or mopeds (with 50cc engines or less) was added to the survey in 2021, the percentage has remained steady at 2%.

Figure 3b. Non-motorcyclists Vehicle Driven, 2017-2023

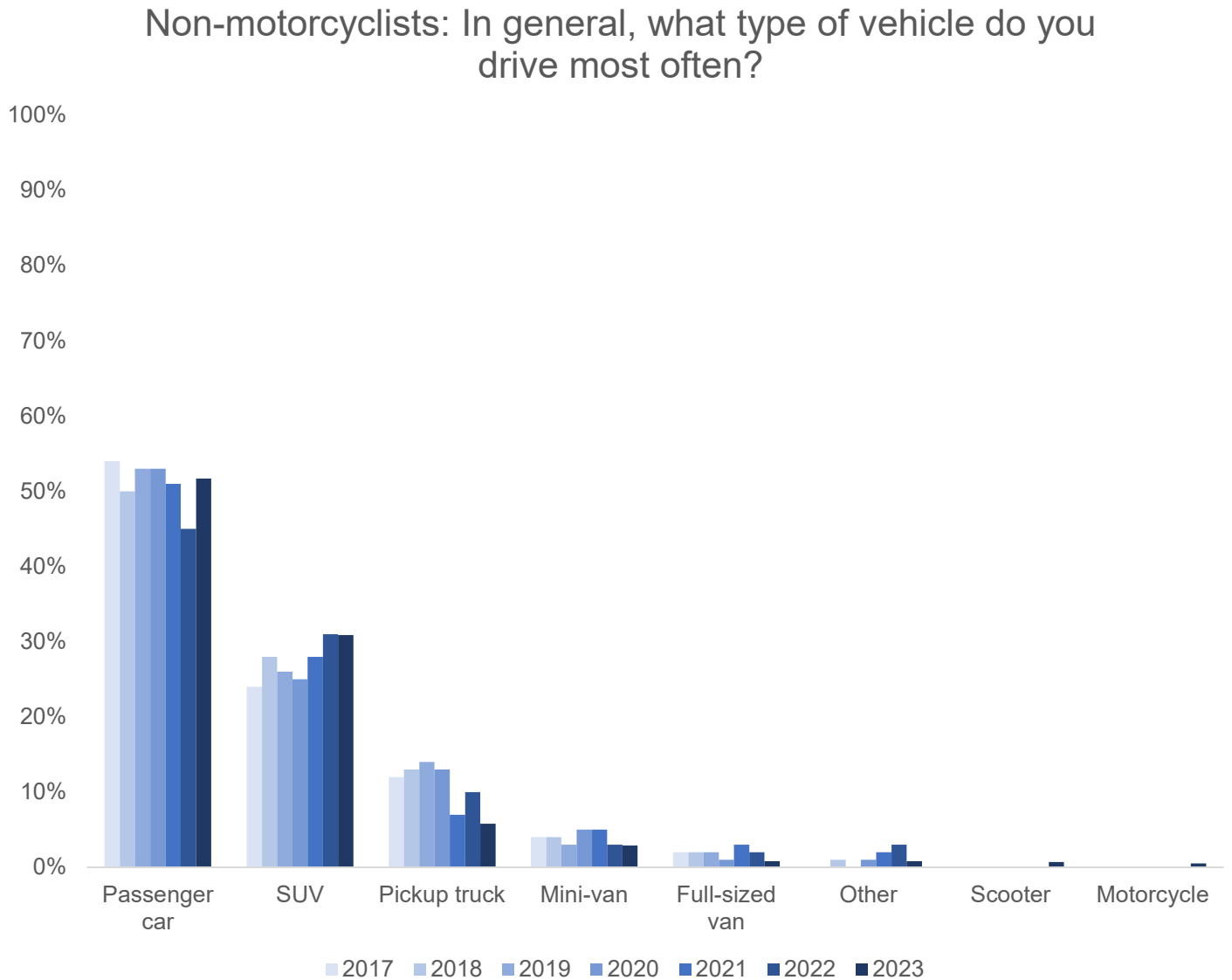
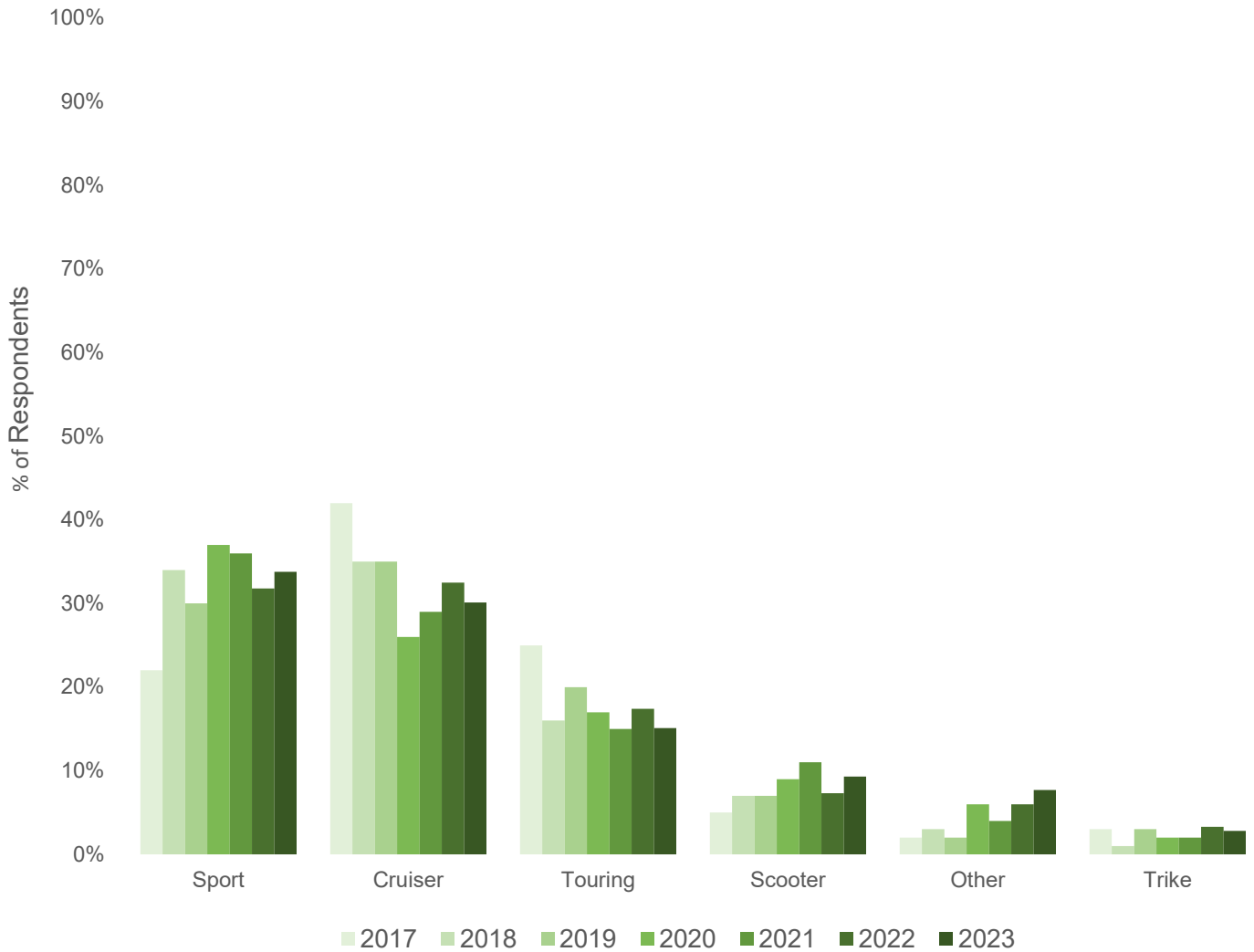


Figure 3b above shows the responses to the vehicle type question among non-motorcyclists for each project year. In all seven years, passenger cars have been the most popular vehicle, jumping up seven percentage points from 45% in 2022 to 52% in 2023. Sports Utility Vehicles (SUVs) continue to come in second place, remaining at 31% in 2023 after increasing steadily through the project years.

This year saw a slight decrease in pickup truck drivers, from 10% in 2022 to 7% in 2023. For the first time since 2017, 1% said the vehicle they drive most often is a motorcycle, even though they reported not having ridden a motorcycle in the past 12 months.

Motorcyclists: Thinking of the motorcycle that you ride most often, what type of motorcycle is it?



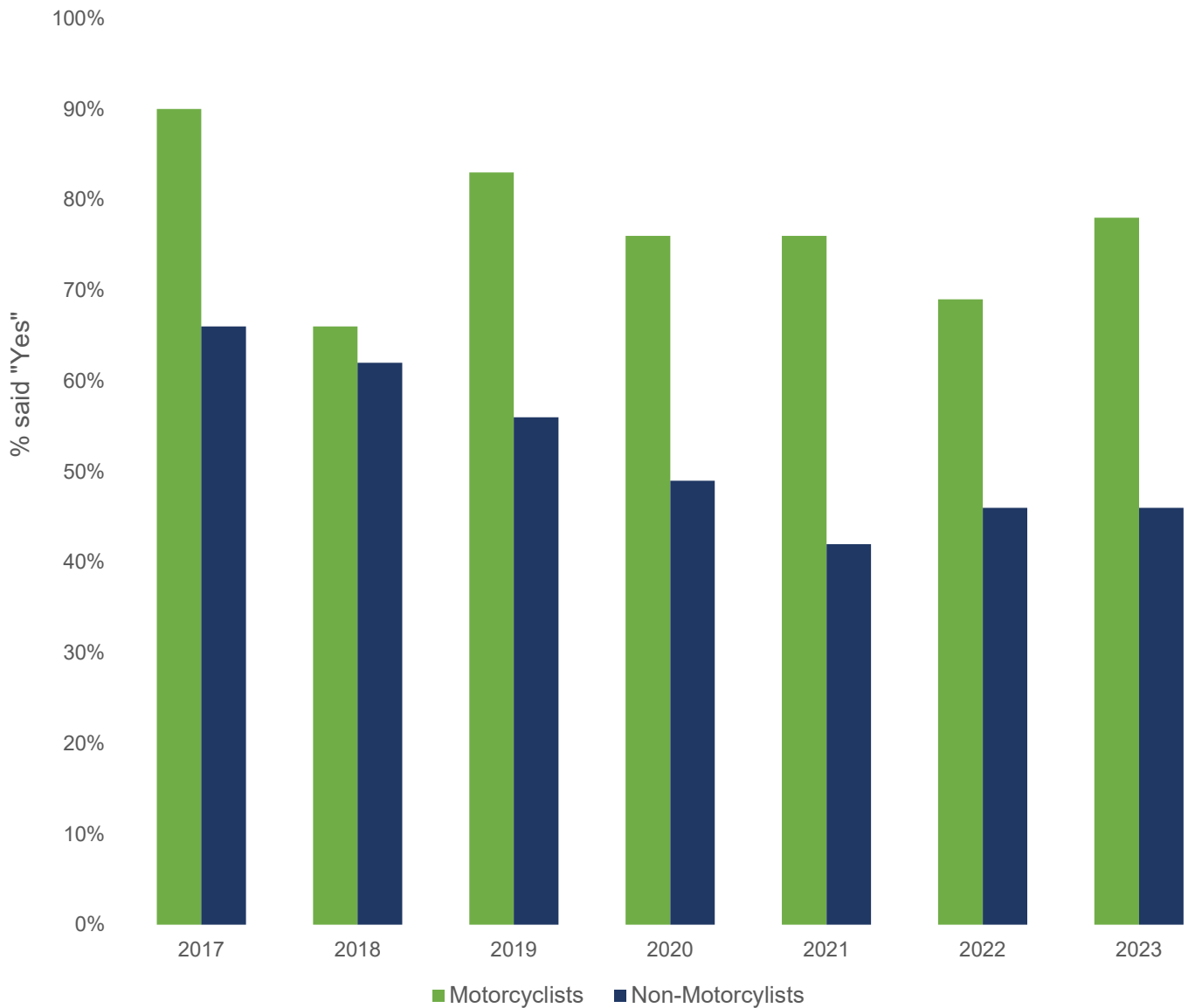
Respondents who reported having driven a motorcycle in the past year were then asked what type of motorcycle they ride most often, displayed above in Figure 4, broken down by project year.

In 2023, sport bikes are the most popular motorcycle type at 34%. Cruisers, the top choice in 2022, are now in

second place with 30%. The percentage of motorcyclists who reported driving a touring most often has decreased by 10 percentage points since 2017, while those who reported driving a scooter (with more than 50cc engines) has increased slightly from 5% in 2017 to 9% in 2023.

In the past few months, have you seen or heard a safety message that said: *Watch for Motorcycles*?



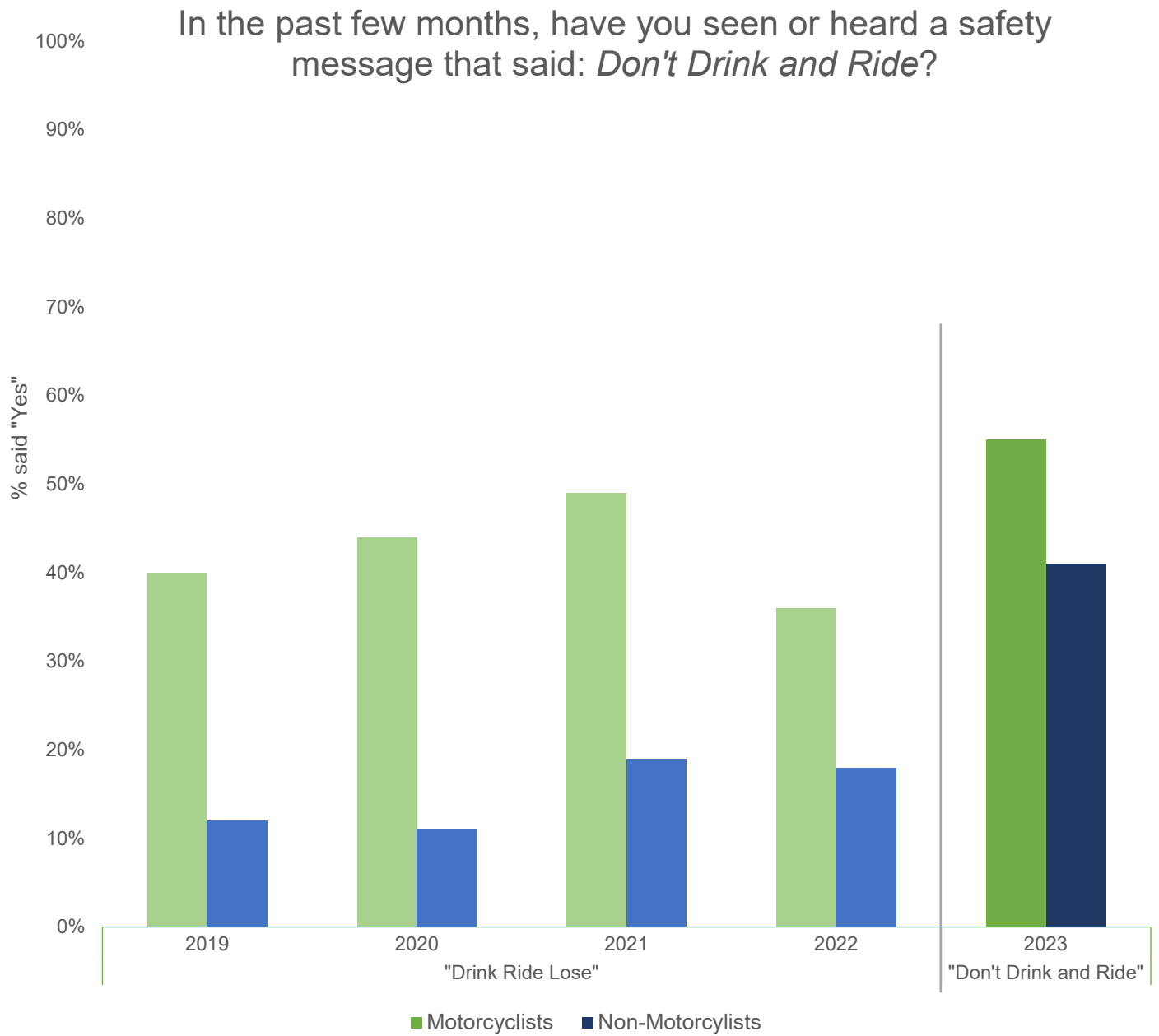
All respondents were asked whether they had seen or heard the safety message *Watch for Motorcycles* in the past few months. These responses are broken down by project year for both motorcyclists and non-motorcyclists in Figure 5.

Among motorcyclists, 78% of respondents reported having seen or heard the message in the past few months, up 9 percentage points from 2022. The percentage of non-motorcyclists who saw the message remained the same at 46%, after experiencing a slow

decline through the project years. Among motorcyclists, awareness has seen an overall decline of 12 percentage points since 2017, while non-motorcyclist awareness has seen a 10-point decrease.

This safety message, which is geared toward non-motorcyclists, has the greatest awareness of all three messages among both motorcyclists *and* non-motorcyclists, as shown in the figures on the following pages.

Figure 6. *Don't Drink and Ride*¹ by Motorcyclists and Non-motorcyclists, 2019-2023

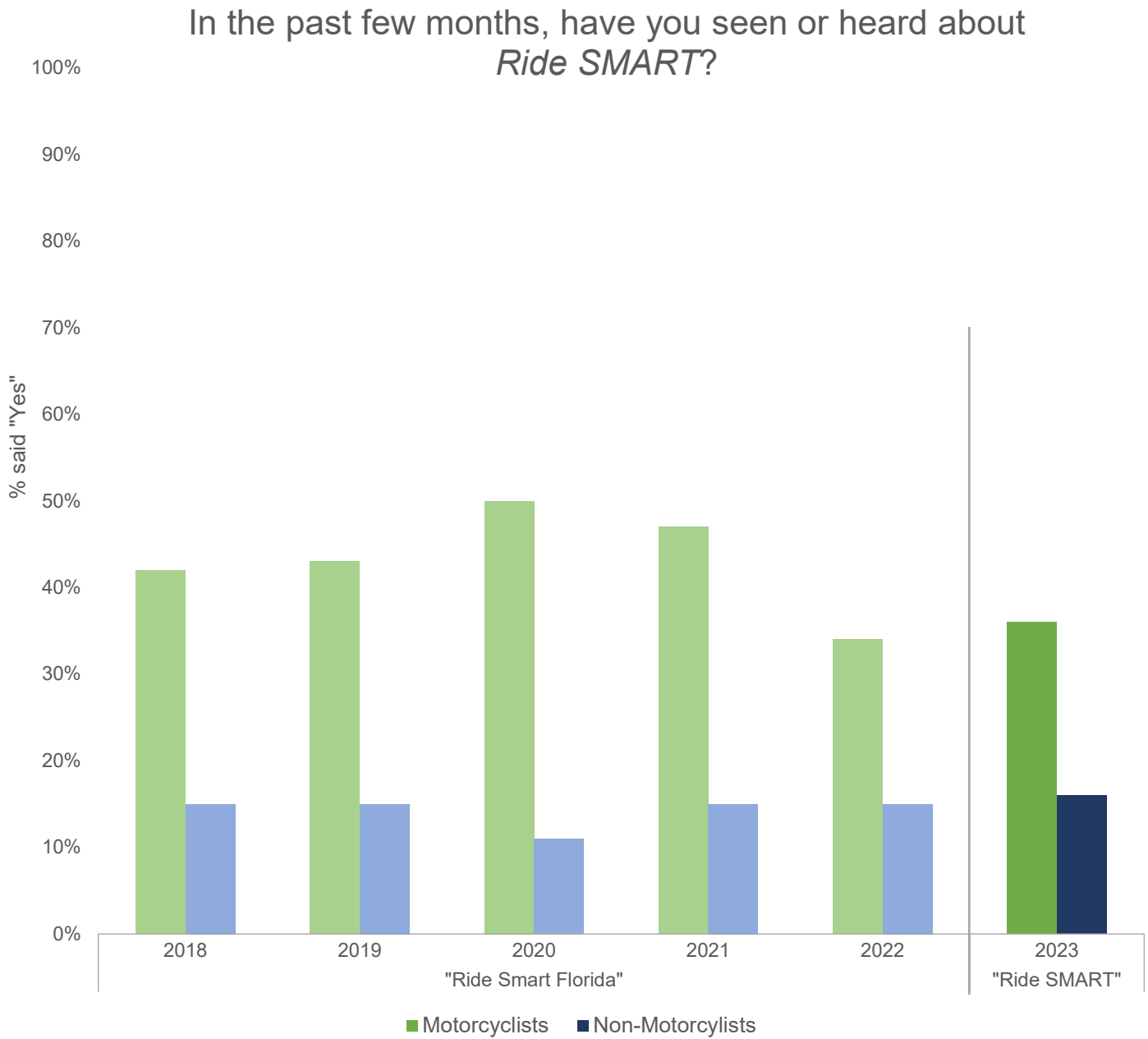


Respondents were also asked whether in the past few months they had seen or heard the safety message *Don't Drink and Ride*, which is geared toward motorcyclists. Prior to 2023, respondents were asked about a similar message, *Drink Ride Lose*, which was added in 2019 and is included in Figure 6 above.

Don't Drink and Ride awareness among both motorcyclists and non-motorcyclists is much greater than that of *Drink Ride Lose* in 2022. Among motorcyclists, awareness increased by 19 percentage points, from 36% to 55%. Although the message is intended for motorcyclists, the increase was even more dramatic among non-motorcyclists, rising 23 points from 18% to 41%.

Finally, respondents were asked whether they had seen or heard about *Ride SMART* in the past few months. This message also changed slightly in 2023, from *Ride Smart Florida* in previous project years. Both messages are displayed above in Figure 7, broken down by project year.

Although the message wording changed slightly since 2022, awareness remained largely unchanged, increasing by just two percentage points among motorcyclists (36%) and one percentage point among non-motorcyclists (16%).

Figure 8. Awareness by Motorcycle Usage, 2023

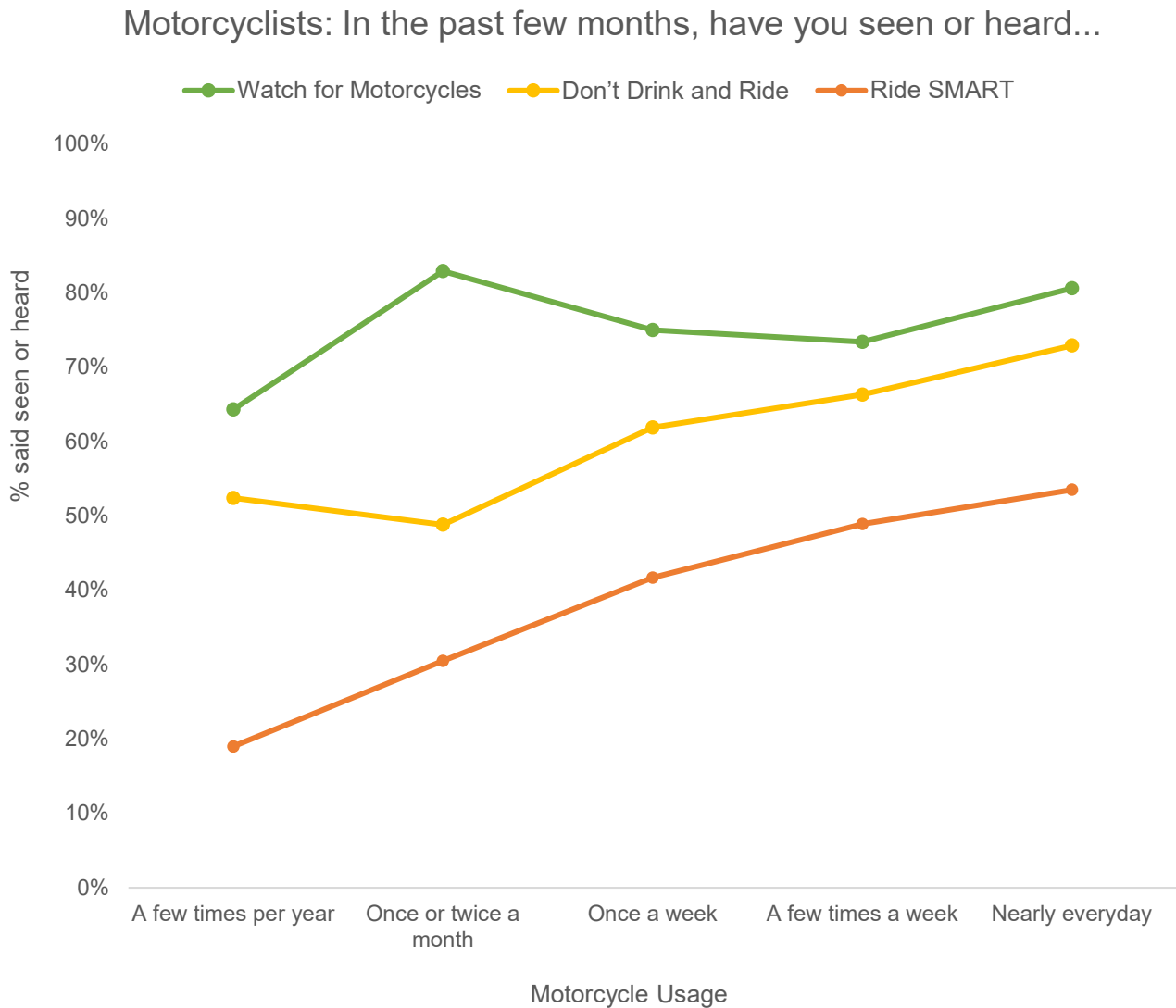


Figure 8 displays the percentage of motorcyclists who indicated they had seen or heard each of the campaign messages, broken down by reported frequency of motorcycle usage.

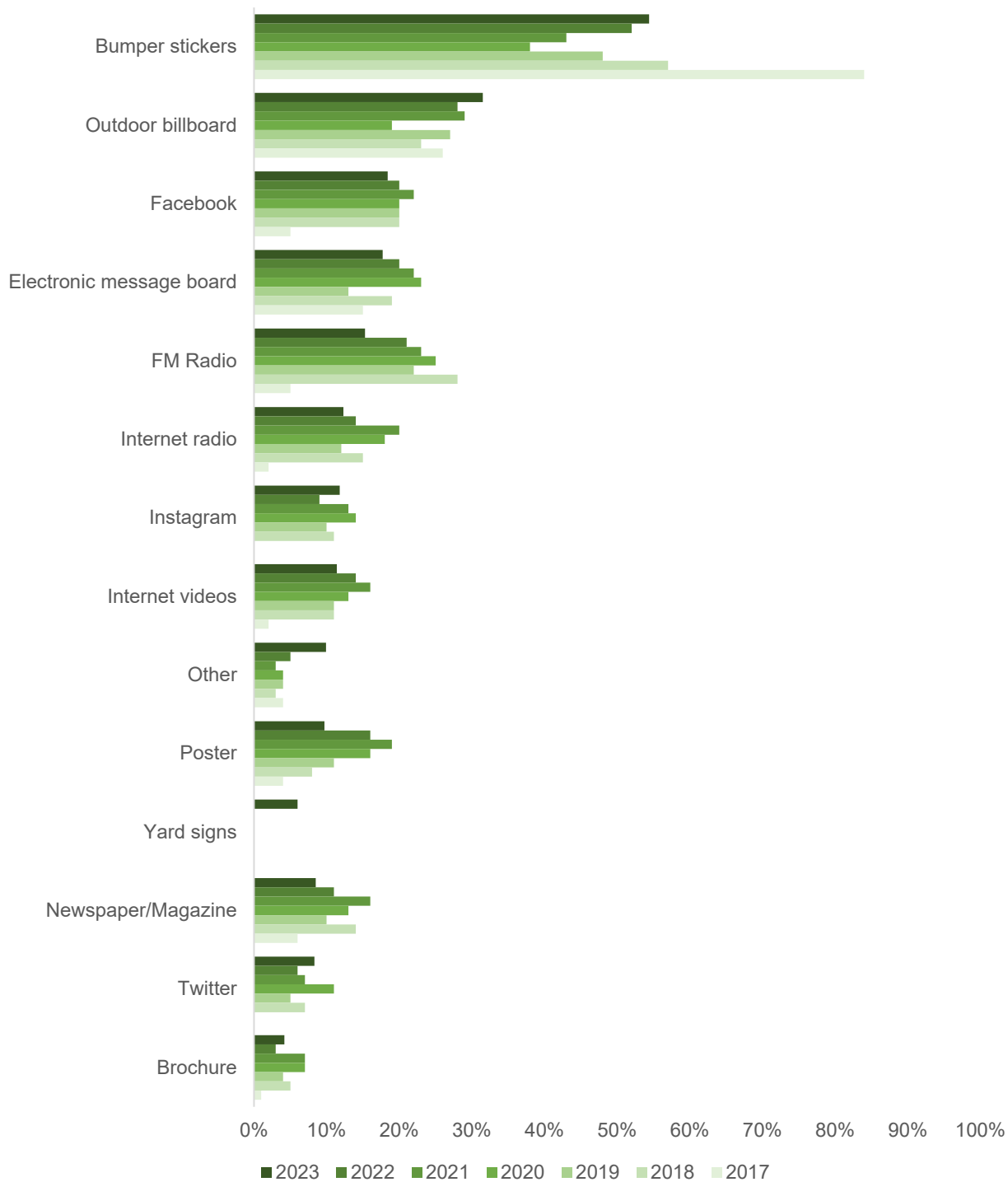
Overall, awareness generally increases with frequency of riding. Exceptions include respondents who report riding once or twice a month, who have the greatest

awareness of *Watch for Motorcycles* at 83%, the lowest awareness of *Don't Drink and Ride* at 49%.

Ride SMART, which has the lowest overall awareness, follows a more linear pattern, with the lowest awareness among those who only ride a few times a year (19%), and highest among those who ride nearly every day (54%).

Figure 9a. Motorcyclists Media: *Watch for Motorcycles*, 2017-2023

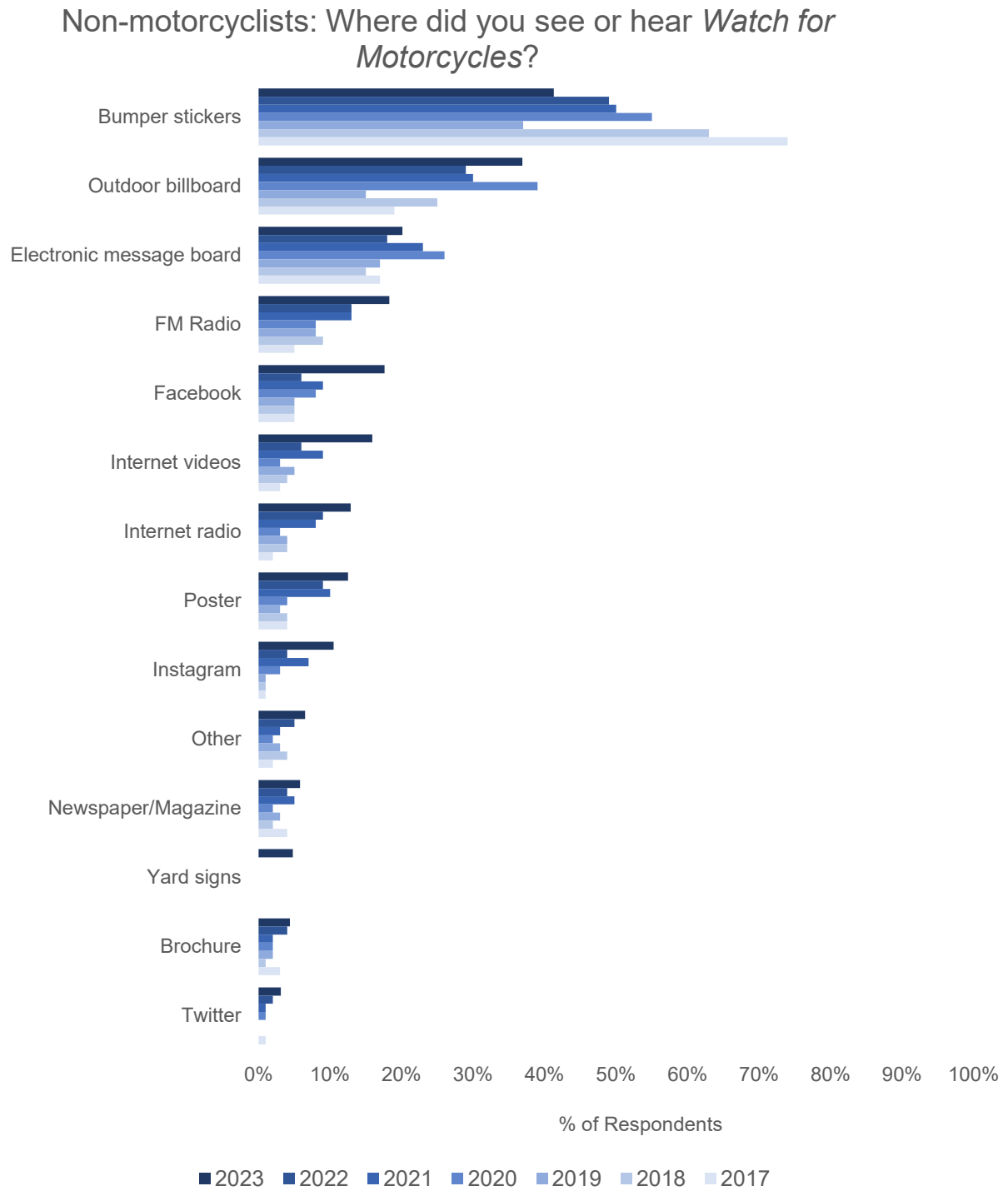
Motorcyclists: Where did you see or hear *Watch for Motorcycles*?



For each safety message, respondents who indicated they saw or heard it in the past few months were then asked *where* they saw or heard it. Figures 9a and 9b display the responses among motorcyclists and non-motorcyclists, broken down by project year. For the seventh year running, the most popular medium on

which motorcyclists reported seeing *Watch for Motorcycles* is bumper stickers, at 54%. This is followed by outdoor billboards with 32% and Facebook at 18%. Yard signs were added as a response in 2023, on which 6% of respondents reported having seen the message.

Bumper stickers are also the top choice among non-motorcyclists at 41%, down from 49% in 2022. This was the only medium that declined in 2023, with all other media choices seeing year-over-year increases. Bumper stickers are again followed by outdoor billboards with

29%, and electronic billboards with 20%. Twitter was the least popular medium for *Watch for Motorcycles*, with just 2% of respondents reporting that is where they saw the message.

Figure 10a. Motorcyclists Media: *Don't Drink and Ride*³, 2019-2023

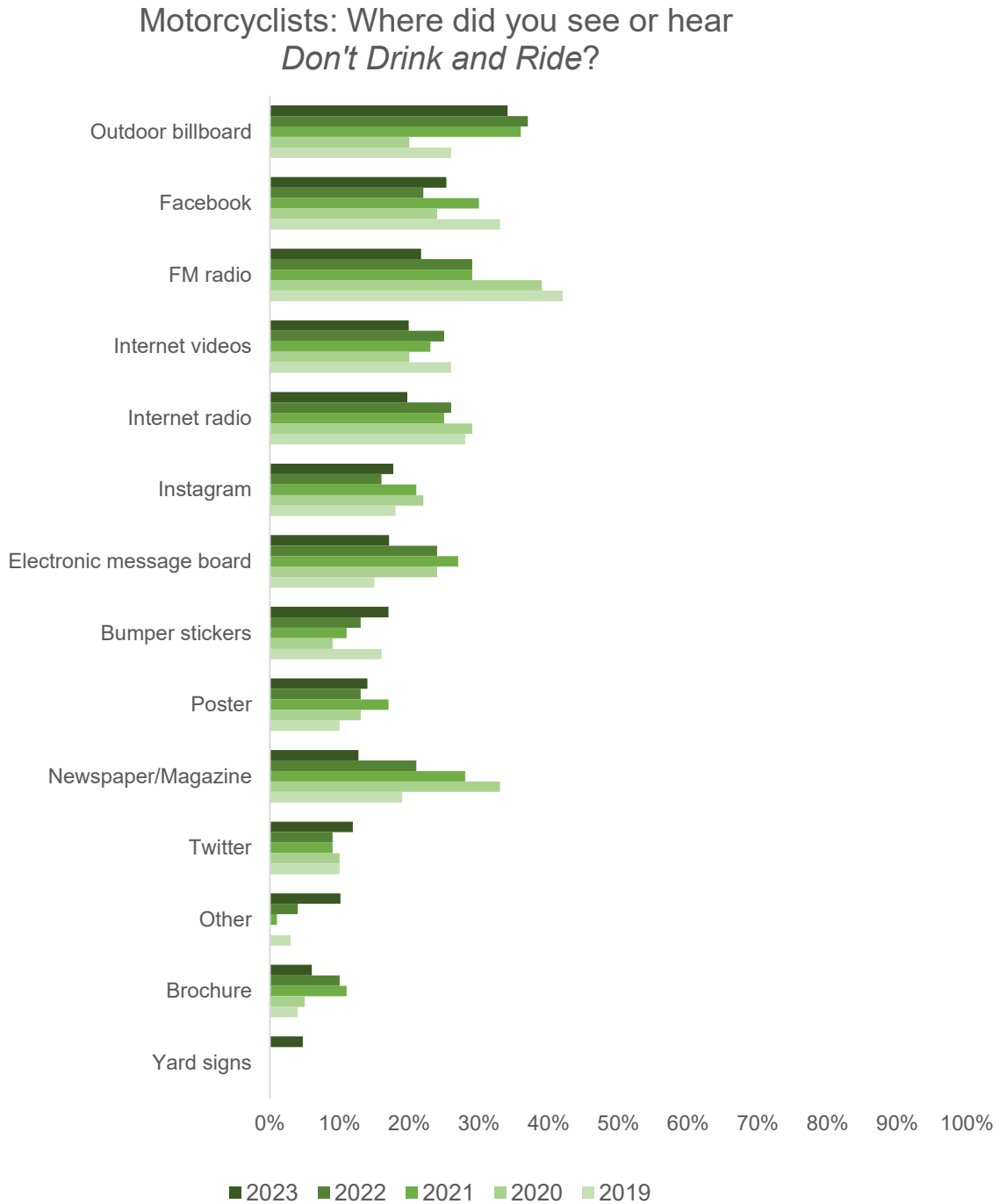


Figure 10a above displays the responses of motorcyclists when asked where they saw or heard *Don't Drink and Ride*, broken down by project year. It is important to note that 2019-2022 percentages reflect the media for *Drink Ride Lose*, the message used prior to 2023.

Outdoor billboard was the most popular response among motorcyclists, down 3 percentage points from 2022, at 34%. Facebook came in second place, with 25%, up from 22% last year. Twenty-two percent of motorcyclists said they heard *Don't Drink and Ride* on FM radio, decreasing from 29% in 2022. Yard signs were the least popular choice, with 5% indicating that is where they saw the message.

Figure 10b. Non-Motorcyclists Media: *Don't Drink and Ride*⁴, 2019-2023

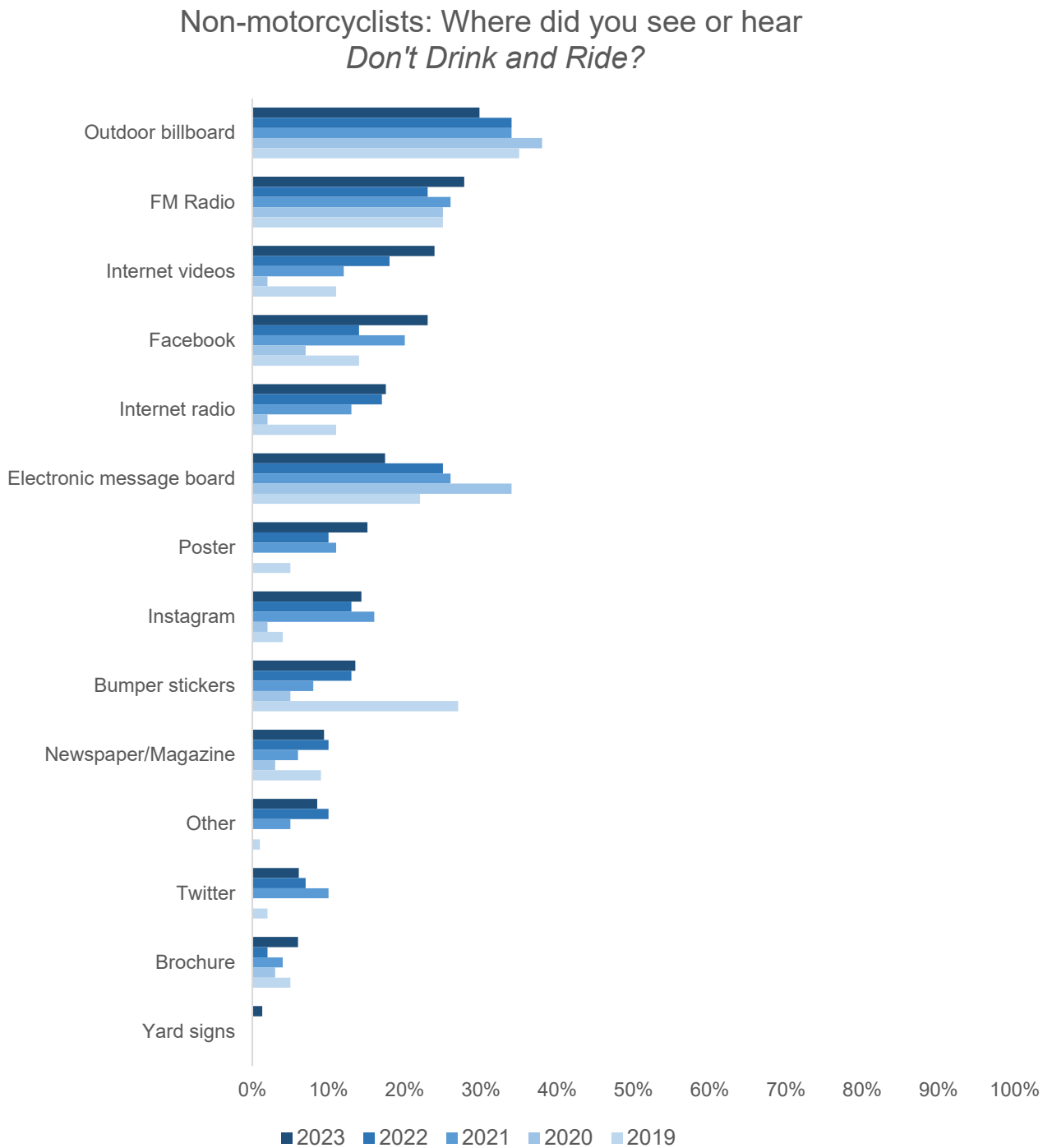


Figure 10b shows where non-motorcyclists saw *Don't Drink and Ride*, broken down by project year. Outdoor billboards also had the greatest percentage of responses among non-motorcyclists when asked where they saw *Don't Drink and Ride* with 30%, decreasing slightly from

34% in 2022 for *Drink Ride Lose*. It is followed by FM radio and internet videos, with 28% and 24%, respectively. Just 1% of non-motorcyclists reported having seen the message on a yard sign.

Motorcyclists: Where did you see or hear *Ride SMART*?

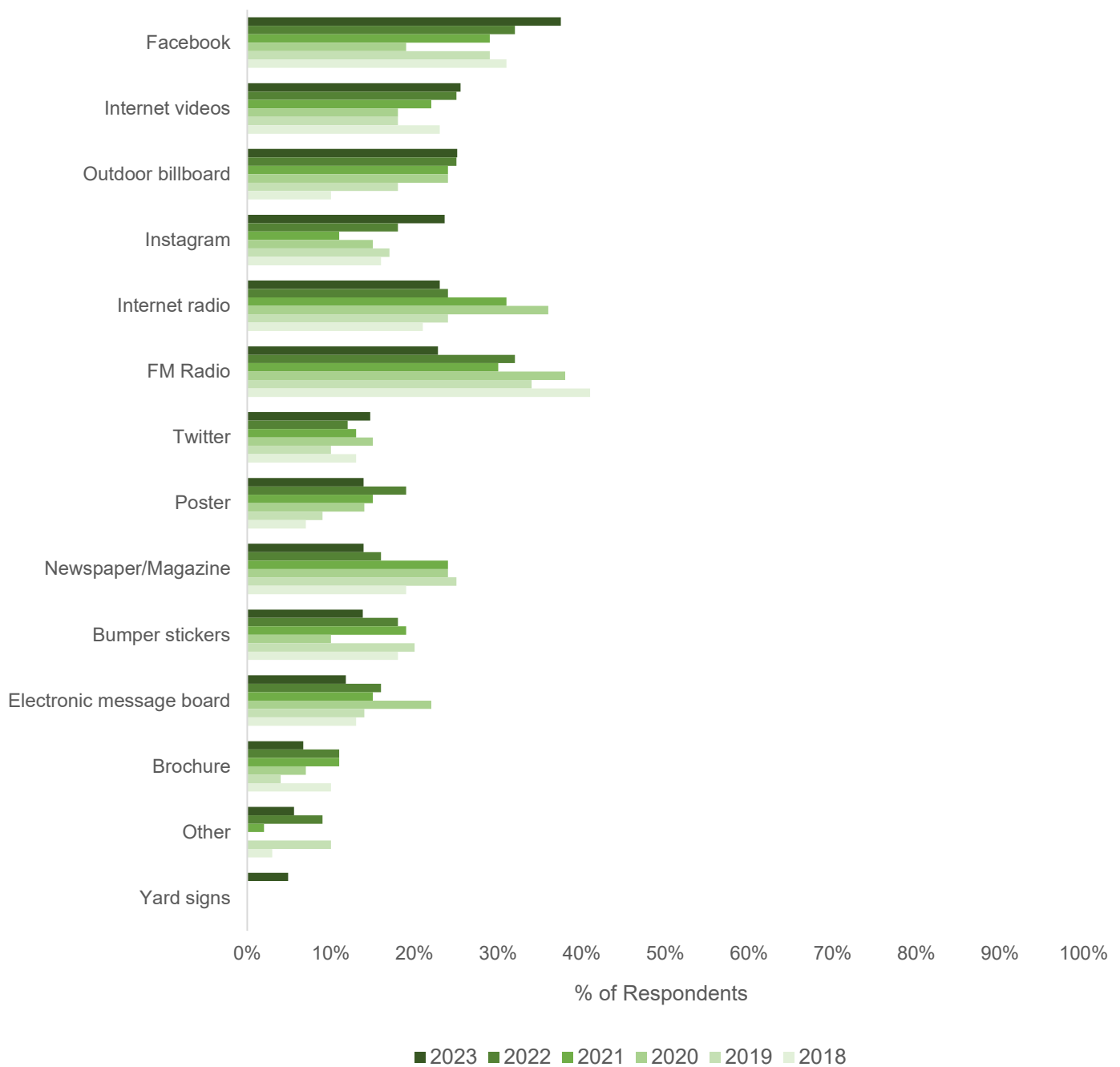
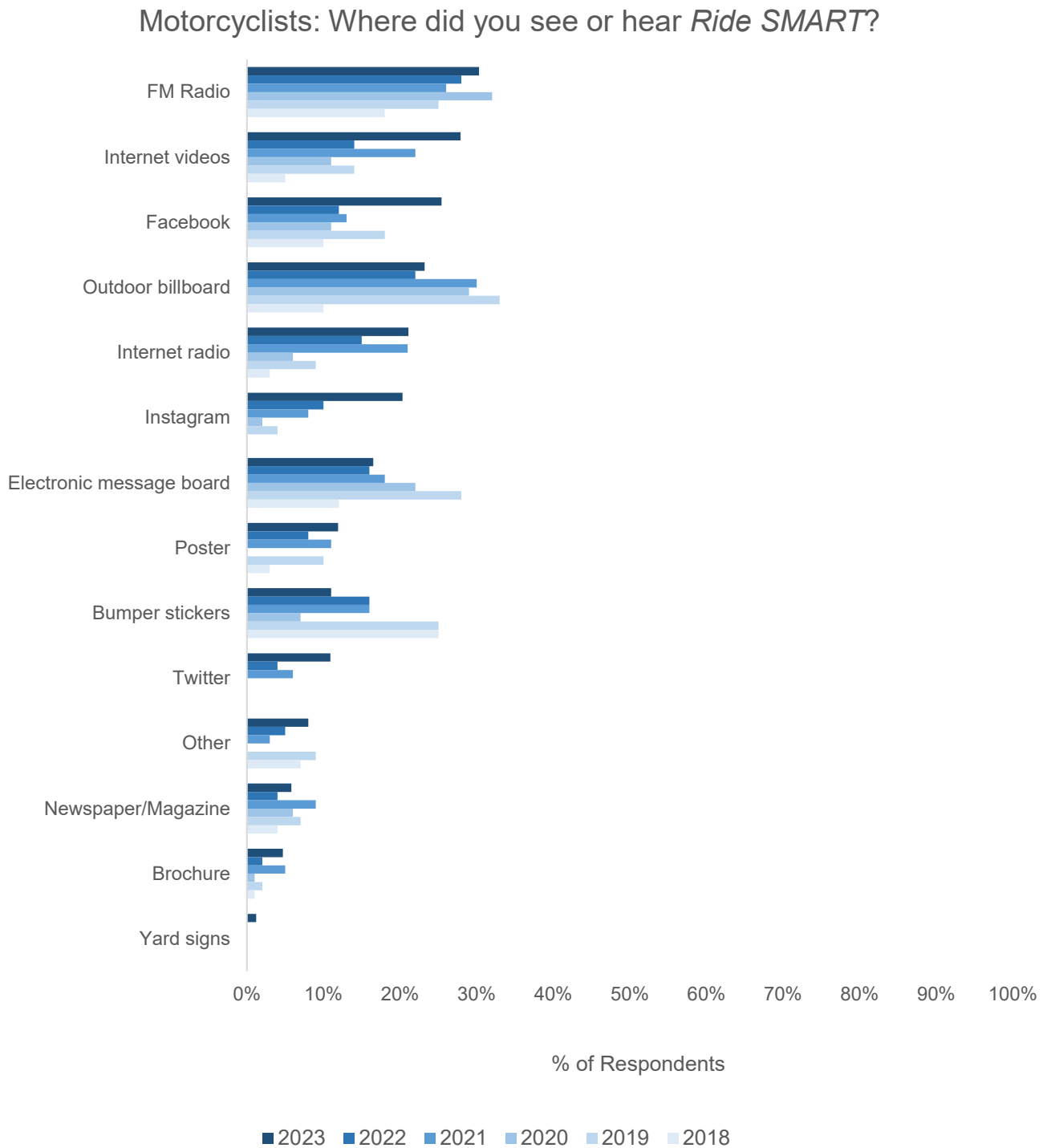


Figure 11a displays the media on which motorcyclists saw *Ride Smart*, along with the *Ride Smart Florida* media in previous years. Motorcyclists reported seeing or hearing about *Ride SMART* on Facebook most frequently in 2023, at 38%, up from 32% in 2022 for *Ride Smart Florida*. Internet videos and outdoor billboards are

in a very close second and third, with 26% and 25%, respectively, each of which increased by one percentage point from 2022. FM radio saw a substantial decrease, from 32% in 2022 to 23% in 2023. Once again, yard signs were the least popular medium, with just 5% of motorcyclists.

Figure 11b. Non-Motorcyclists Media: *Ride SMART*⁶, 2019-2023

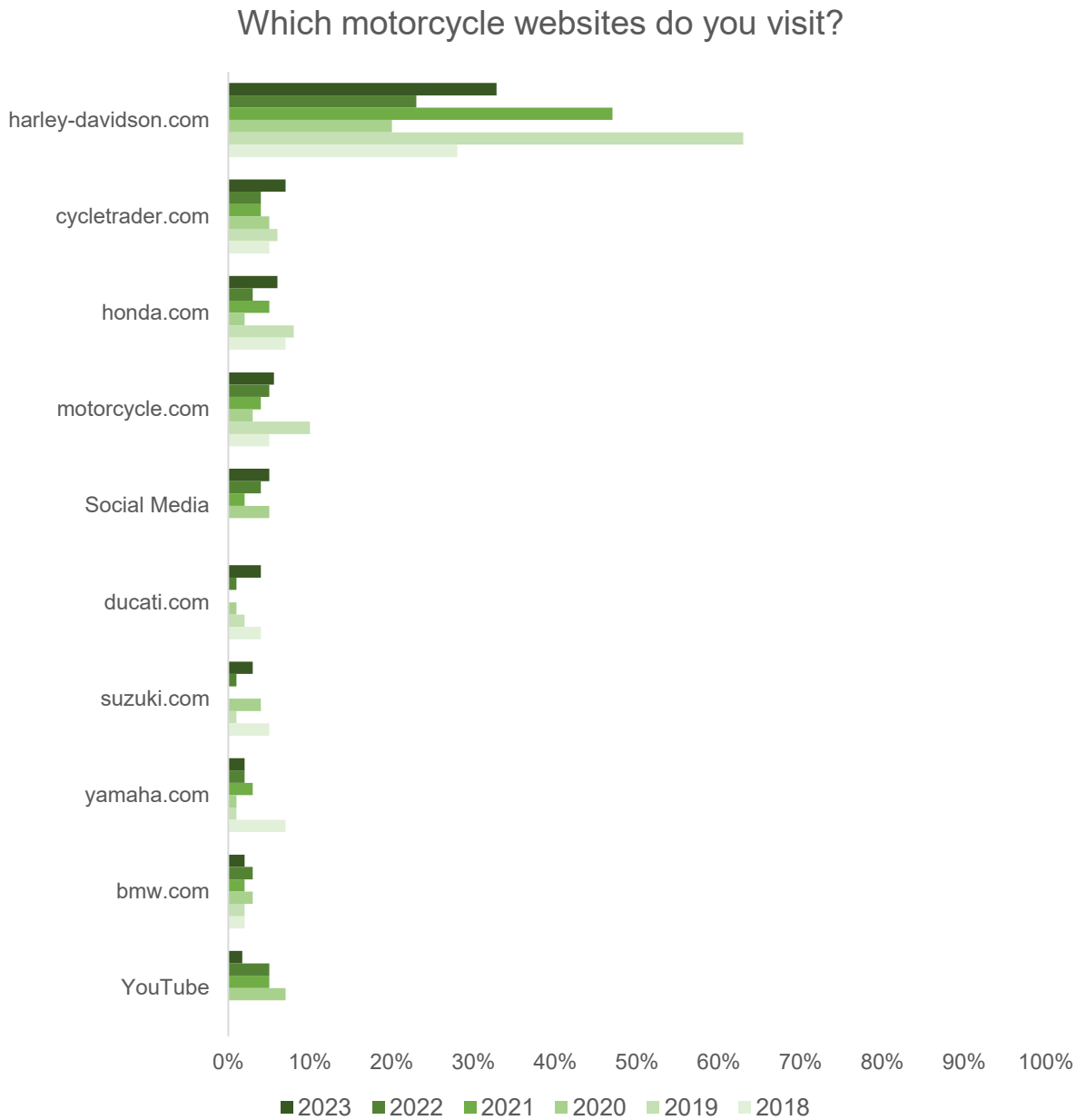


Thirty percent of non-motorcyclists who reported seeing or hearing about *Ride SMART* said they heard about it on FM radio, up slightly from 28% in 2022 with *Ride Smart Florida*. Internet videos are in a close second place with 28%, followed by Facebook with 25%.

Once again, just 1% of non-motorcyclists said they saw *Ride SMART* on a yard sign.

Figure 12. Motorcycle Websites, 2018-2023

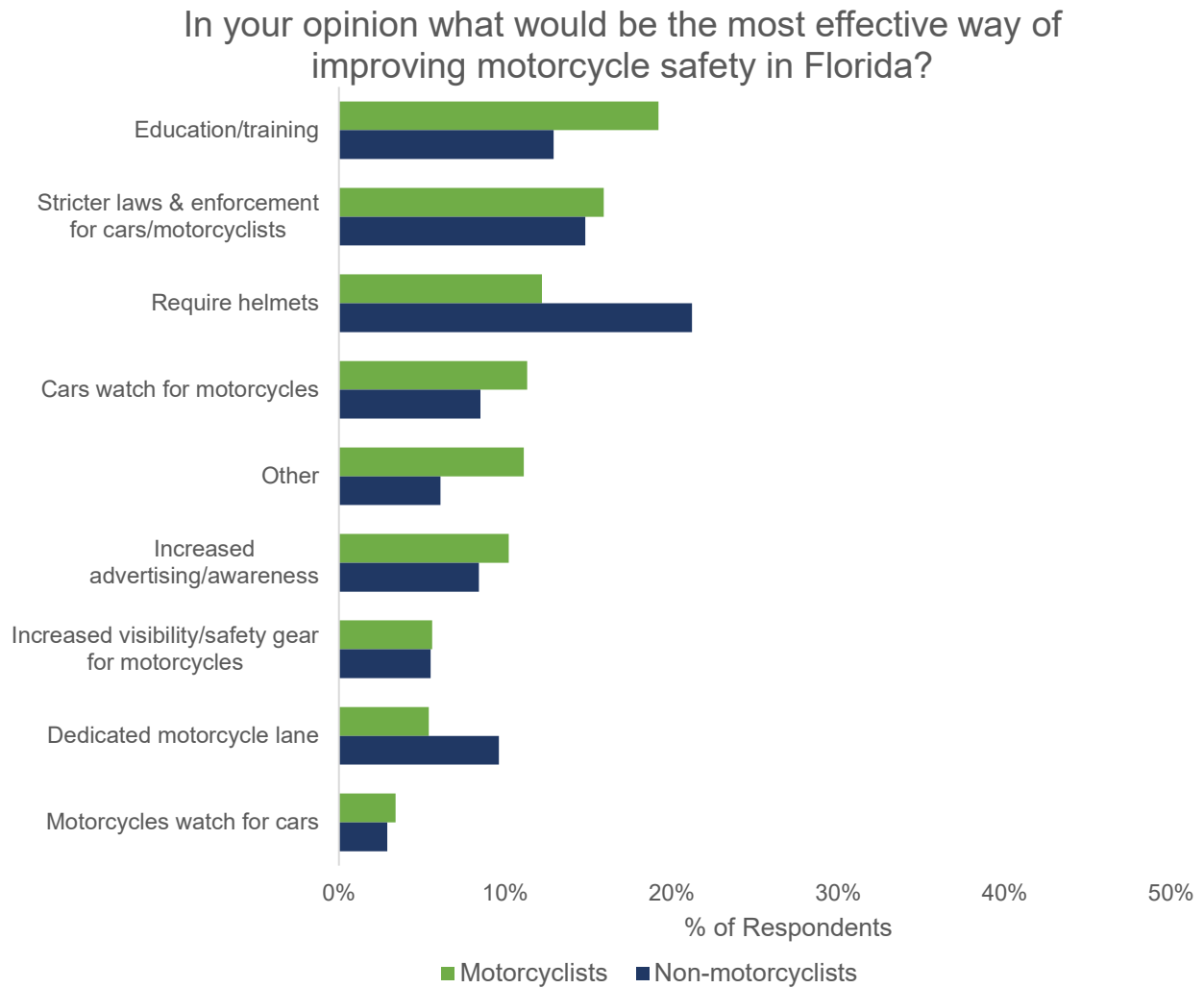


Motorcyclists were also asked whether they visit websites specific to motorcycles. Those who answered “yes” were then asked which ones they visit. This question is asked open-ended, and then recorded into categories during data analysis, shown above in Figure 12 broken down by project year. In all project years,

Harley-davidson.com has been the most popular response by a wide margin, increasing by 10 percentage points to 33% in 2023. In a distant second place is cycletrader.com with 7%, followed by honda.com with 6%.

*Social media and YouTube categories were added in 2020.

Figure 13. Safety Improvement by Motorcyclists and Non-motorcyclists, 2023⁷



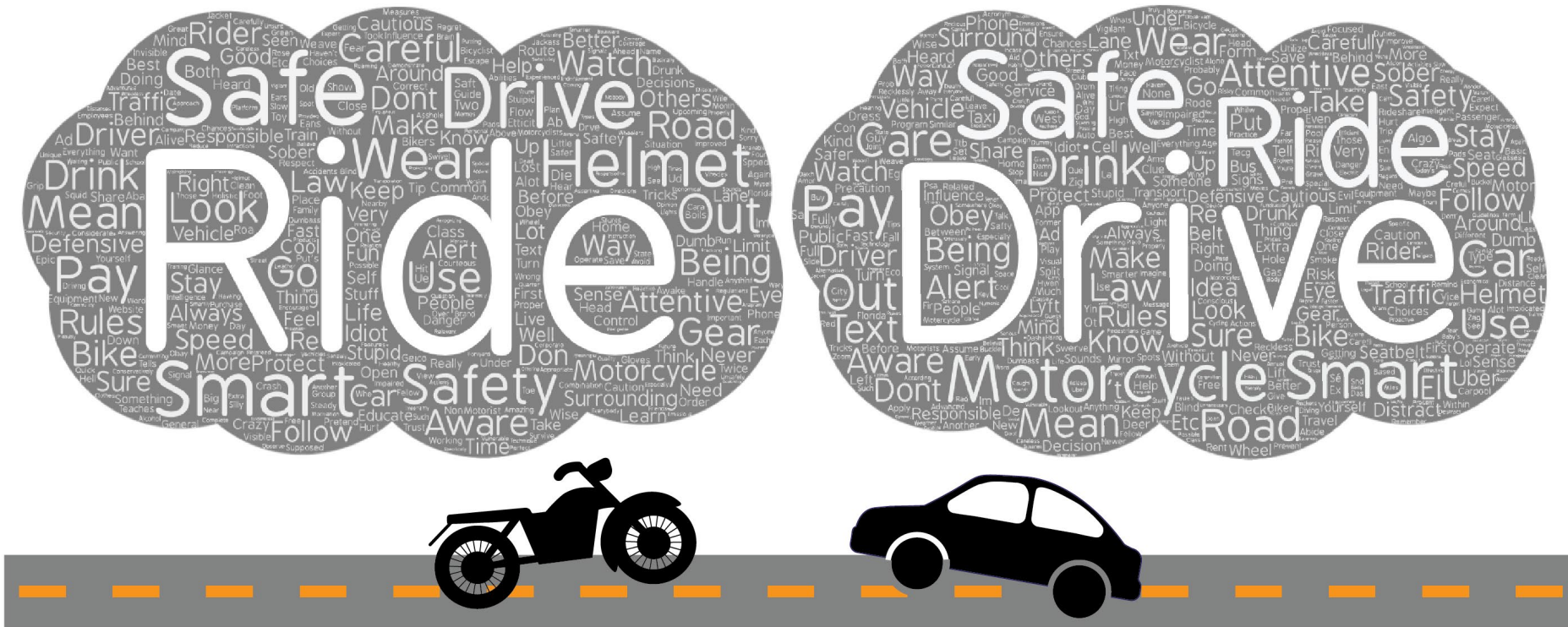
Respondents were asked their opinions about most effective way to improve motorcycle safety in Florida, which was recoded into the categories listed above in Figure 13, broken down by motorcyclists and non-motorcyclists. Among motorcyclists, the most popular response was more education and training. Requiring motorcyclists to wear helmets was the most frequent response from non-motorcyclists,

with 19%. In second place for both motorcyclists (16%) and non-motorcyclists (15%) is stricter laws and enforcement for both vehicle types. Eleven percent of motorcyclists said cars watching for motorcycles would be most effective, along with 9% of non-motorcyclists. The least popular response among both groups, with 3% each, was motorcycles watching for cars.

An additional open-ended question was added to the survey this project year asking respondents what “Ride SMART” means to them. The word clouds above in Figure 14 show the common themes among motorcyclists (on the left) and non-motorcyclists (on the right).

Some of the most common words used were “safe,” “ride,” “drive,” “helmet,” and “drink.” Many respondents also used “attentive,” “aware,” and “careful.” For a full list of the open-ended responses, see Appendix II.
